L-3 Linkabit Products Support Full-Rate Production of Warfighter Information Network-Tactical (WIN-T) Increment 2

SAN DIEGO, November 19, 2015 – L-3 Linkabit, developer of the highly advanced Network-Centric Waveform (NCW) currently in use by the U.S. Army's Warfighter Information Network-Tactical (WIN-T) program, announced today that its RMPM-1000 modem and FSS-4180 antenna products will support the Full-Rate Production (FRP) and fielding of the WIN-T Increment 2 (Inc 2) program. The L-3 Linkabit products were ordered by General Dynamics, the WIN-T Inc 2 prime contractor.

In June, the Army approved the FRP of WIN-T Inc 2. The system includes the L-3 SATCOM On-The-Move technology that will provide soldiers with communications and command and control capabilities that are essential for the Army's tactical network and Future Force 2025.

"The NCW waveform, the RMPM-1000 modem and the FSS-4180 antenna are a critical part of the U.S. Army's tactical network modernization, providing critical beyond-line-of-sight connectivity in remote and immature theaters," said Elissa Seidenglanz, president of L-3 Linkabit.
