The Talon Cryptographic Token 2 Lite ECU, KOV-26B, supports High Assurance Internet Protocol Encryptor (HAJPE) Version 1.3.5, and Secure Communications Interoperability Protocol (SCIP) Voice Version 210/230.

The decision to use the KOV-26B must be made in a total system context employing an Information Systems Security Engineering process and appropriate certification and accreditation process.
